AUSTRALIAN racing driver Paul Weel and his wife Emma are waving the chequered flag on their sports-friendly mega mansion on the Gold Coast waterfront, putting it on the market for \$11.95m.

The couple bought the property at 14 Maryland Ave, Carrara, in 2011 for \$2.4m, where they lived for five years before moving to 504 The Esplanade in Palm Beach in 2015, while they worked on designs for a new home at the Maryland address.

Deploying award-winning architect Bayden Goddard, who also designed the Broadbeach Waters mansion of Gold Coast entertainment king and queen Billy and Jackie Cross, which sold last week for \$12.5m, the Weels moved back to Carrara in 2018 when the mansion was complete.

The couple, who have two daughters, Abby, 10, and Mila, 7, said the property, marketed by Michael Kollosche of Kollosche Broadbeach, was a truly multi-generational home, where an extended family could live comfortably, and which was great for entertaining.

# POWER COUPLE BUYS IN BURLEIGH

**P**ROMINENT Queensland business entrepreneurs and philanthropists Cathie Reid and Stuart Giles have bought a beachfront apartment in one of the Gold Coast's most luxurious new developments.

The co-founders of the Icon Cancer Care Group and the Epic Good Foundation took to social media this week to reveal their latest multimillion-dollar investment - a stunning residence in a new boutique project in Burleigh Heads.

"Norfolk", due for completion in April, is a 10-level building of just 15 apartments on Goodwin Tce by developer Forme and designed by architect Koichi Takada. Only one half-floor residence remains for sale,



with 90 per cent selling off the plan in the first two months of the project's launch last year. The remaining apartment on level two is priced at \$4.1m, spans 287sqm and comprises a media room, butler's pantry, integrated barbecue kitchen, beach room for storage and optional upgrade to a temperature-controlled wine display bar.

The building will have a ground-floor gymnasium, pool, sun lounging deck and sauna, while penthouse apartments will

enjoy a private rooftop terrace with BBQ, dining and entertainment areas and private infinity-edge lap pools.

This week, Ms Reid and Mr Giles posted a cute shot of their dog, George, outside the building with the caption: "I think he likes his birthday present! We're all looking forward to spending plenty

of time with him here from April #beachhouse #Burleigh-BeachDog."

The Brisbane-based couple, with an estimated net wealth of \$550m, sold their 28-site Epic Pharmacy chain for roughly \$37m and have also recently sold down their stake in Australia's largest cancer care provider, Icon Group.

The couple also co-owns Makepeace Island with Sir Richard Branson, Virgin Australia co-founder Brett Godfrey and former Swisse Vitamins chief executive Radek Sali.

They have also invested up to \$5m to roll out cricket's Australian Premier League nationally this year.



## Boutique is all the rage

ANOTHER boutique, luxury apartment project is bound for the blue-chip Brisbane suburb of New Farm as competition heats up.

Acclaimed architect Joe Adsett and his development partner Craig Purdy are teaming up again to create "Arcilla" - a five-storey apartment building at 28 Maxwell St.

There are now only two sky homes remaining in the New Farm project. The pair submitted plans to the Brisbane City Council shortly before Christmas.

They paid \$4m for the 845sqm site with its existing four-storey apartment block.

Plans are for nine apartments with views across the Brisbane River to the CBD from each balcony and living space, consciously designed to promote indoor/outdoor living. There will be landscaping on all levels including

The ex-Big Brother star-turned-influencer (inset with son Forest) and partner Lachlan Waugh are almost finished upgrades to the upstairs living area at their acreage property known as La Casa Grande at 47 Worongary Rd, Tallai.

They bought the four-bedroom home for \$975,000 in August 2019, embarking on a major restoration project to bring the Spanish-inspired mansion back to its former glory.
